THE COMMUNITY

The New Milford School District is located in a small suburban community in the heart of northern Bergen County approximately 13 miles northwest of midtown Manhattan. We are a socially and economically diverse community and our close proximity to New York City provides a variety of educational, cultural, and recreational opportunities while maintaining a unique small town character flavor. The district serves approximately 2,000 students in grades K-12, with a growing Multi-Language Learner population representing over 42 different languages spoken at home.

THE HIGH SCHOOL

New Milford High School is a four-year comprehensive public high school that addresses the needs of all of its students and has as its chief emphasis preparation for education beyond high school. Current school population is 575 with 139 students enrolled in the 12th grade.

GPA is cumulative and comprises final grades from all courses, including Physical Education/Health (courses designated Pass/Fail are not included). New Milford uses a differential weighting system. Courses labeled Honors receive an additional .5 of a quality point, and Advanced Placement, 1 additional quality point. These weights are used solely for the purpose of computing a Grade Point Average. A 7th semester GPA is forwarded to colleges on the mid-year report.

CURRICULUM

Students are scheduled for seven courses which meet daily. Our program of study is designed to serve the interests and needs of all students. To receive a New Milford High School diploma, the class of 2024 must earn a minimum of 130 credits including: four years of English; one year of World History/Cultures; two years of United States History; three years of Mathematics; three years of Science; one year of World Languages; one year of Career Education & Consumer, Family, Life Skills; one year of Visual and Performing Arts (VPA); a semester of Financial Literacy; and one year of Physical Education and/or Health for each year a student is in attendance at New Milford.

Elective offerings for the class of 2024 include but are not limited to: Visual and Performing Arts: All art and music classes, Career Education and Consumer, Family, and Life Skills: Business Education, 21st Century Life and Careers, Family and Consumer Sciences classes. Presently, there are 24 Honors courses and 13 Advanced Placement courses listed below as well as 2-D Art and Design and 3-D Art and Design. Students also have the opportunity to take Dual Enrollment courses offered through Bergen Community College (H Studio Art, H Tomorrow's Teacher) and Ramapo College (H Spanish IV, H French IV, H Mandarin IV). New Milford partnered with Bergen Community College to offer the Early College Program to eligible 11th graders interested in earning an Associate Degree.
