**Clubs provide great ways to make friends with people who have similar interests.**

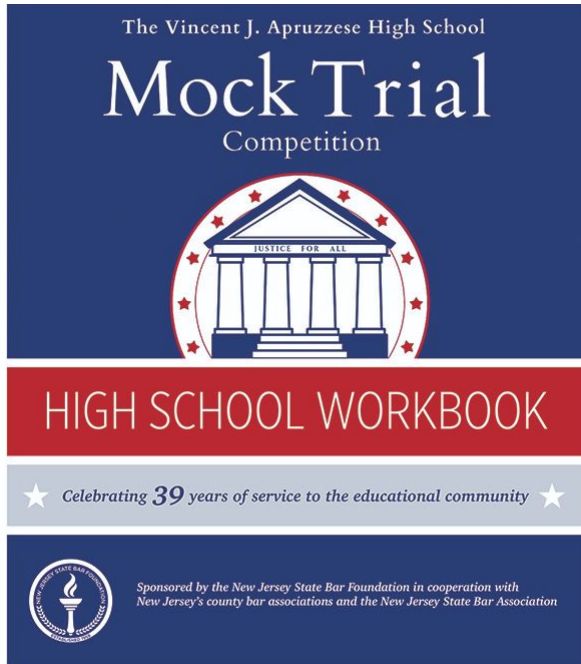
**Clubs also provide opportunities for networking outside of school.**

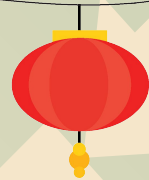
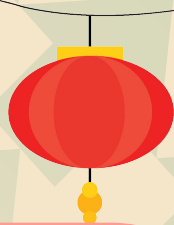

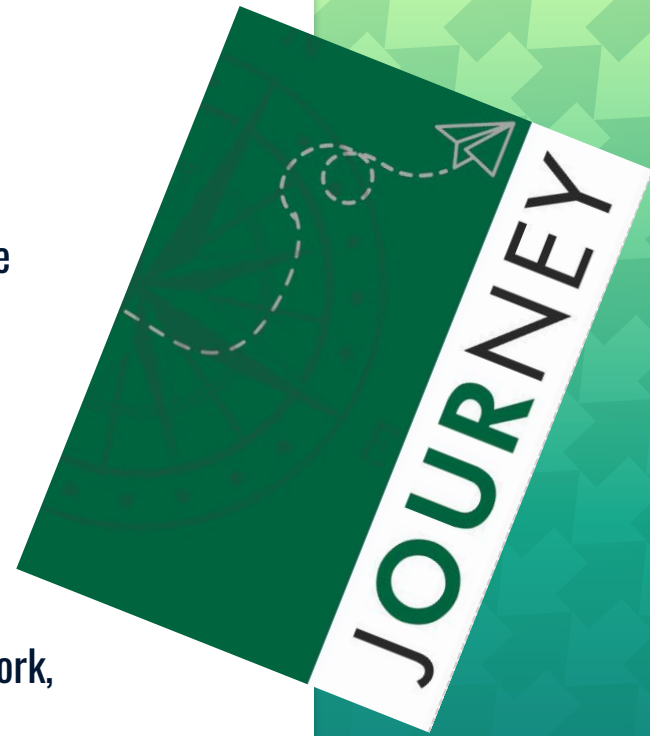
# Yearbook Club- Mrs. Dunn
